#### **School Fees**

#### **State Assessments**

Spring semester brings on our state and federally required assessments. These assessments not only give students an idea of their proficiency levels for the required state standards but also gives teachers an idea of the strengths and weaknesses of an individual student and a specific grade level. As a school, we use the results from these tests to monitor and adjust our lessons to

meet the needs of students. These tests also have a minimum standard required for all students to be considered proficient in math and English skills to move on to any profession or trade school and are tied to graduation.

State assessment results are also used to rate each school in the state in growth, proficiency, graduation rates and participation
